Discussion Questions

1. John Maxwell defines leadership as simply “influence”. Nothing more. Nothing less. And this influence does not necessarily have to be positive. Discuss the perspective that we are all leaders, either positively or negatively influencing others.
2. Dale defines leadership as “Being an example *worthy of following*, and *inspiring* others to follow that example”. What do each of those italicized thoughts mean?
3. It was mentioned that our *influence on* our children is more important than the *obedience of* our children. Do you agree or disagree? Why?
4. When you are with your family, do you make an effort to truly be “present”? How is that working?
5. Consider the story of Adolf Hitler. His first dream was to be a priest. How did his father change the course of history? What could his father (and us today) have done to change the shape of the world?
6. How can we be “present” more with our eyes, ears and heart with our childrens’ lives?
7. Who is God putting in your path... telling you to pick up... to go deep with?
